International Conference on INTERGENERATIONAL SOLIDARITY AND AGEING (the second CE- Ageing International Conference)

INVITATION

The conference will be a central national event at the end of the European Year for Active Ageing and Solidarity between Generations 2012. It is aimed for all stakeholders affected by demographic change in Slovenia but also for participants of the Central European Ageing Platform and European experts.

The representatives of the Republic of Slovenia, non-governmental sector from Slovenia and abroad, local and foreign experts, participants of the project Central European Ageing Platform and others will contribute to the discussions during the conference. At the same time, **schools and non-governmental organizations** will present their posters with best practices of intergenerational co-operation in the lobby hall.

The core of the conference programme is represented by lectures by distinguished foreign experts:

Dr. Vladimir Špidla – ex-EU Commissioner for Employment, Social Affairs and Equal Opportunities in the time when European Commission published Green Paper on Confronting demographic change: *A NEW SOLIDARITY BETWEEN THE GENERATIONS*,

Dr. Tereza Pinto – European expert in the field of valorisation of intergenerational practices,

Dr. Ashgar Zaidi – Professor of International Social Policy, Centre for Research on Ageing/ ESRC Centre for Population Change, School of Social Sciences, University of Southampton, who among others deals also with indicators of active ageing.

Additionally, the Slovenian authors will present processed data of a new extensive Slovenian research **on the needs, abilities and attitudes of Slovenian population, aged 50 years and over** (it will be published in the scientific monograph *Ageing in Slovenia*).

The conference will be held on Monday, 5th November from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm at the Congress Center Brdo pri Kranju. Registration will start at 8:00 am and the pre-conference programme/video at 8:45. Participants will be provided conference proceedings and other professional materials, lunch and refreshment during the breaks. Simultaneous translation (English – Slovene) will be provided during the conference. The participation at the conference is free of charge, there **is no registration fee.**

The conference will also mark the 20th anniversary of Anton Trstenjak Institute of gerontology and intergenerational relations and the memory of Mary Kržič.
