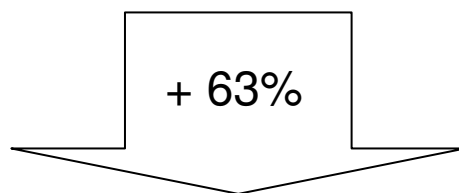
Population is ageing 1

- Lower mortality, longer life expectancy

+10 years in the last 50 years

→ increasing number of older people (65+)

1990: 211.606



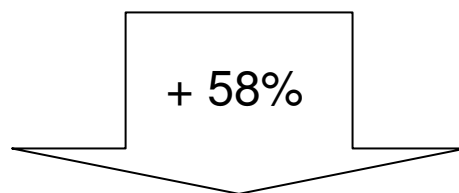
2012: 345.000

Population is ageing 2

- Lower fertility over a longer period

→ increasing share of older people (65+)

1990: 10.6%

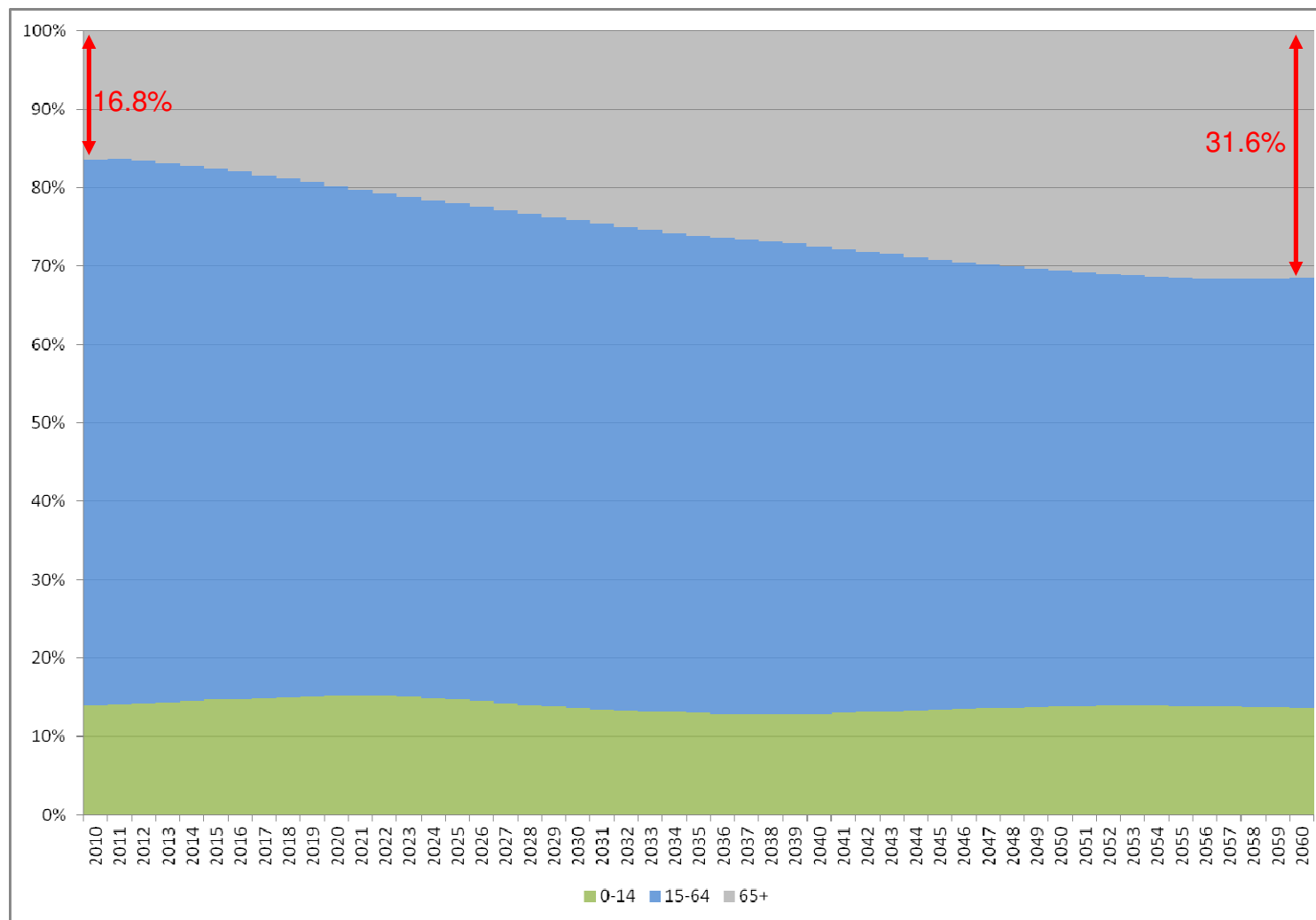


2012: 16.8%

EUROPOP2010 for Slovenia

- Life expectancy to keep increasing
+ 7-8 years by 2060
- Fertility expected to somewhat increase

Elderly population more active 3

Informally active in the society

- taking care of grandchildren
- financial support for families
- consumers
- carers for sick/disabled family
- volunteers

Living conditions of the elderly

→ single households

EU: 40% women 65+, 17% men 65+

→ higher risk of poverty

Slovenia: 20% for 65+, 25% for 75+ (more for women, less for men)

→ social exclusion

Oldest old 1

- growing share of population 80+ (oldest old) (EU 2010: 5%; 2060: 12%)
- more fragile and dependent population
often need help in daily tasks, more intensive health care

Oldest old 2

- formal and informal long-term care

- increased need for formal long-term care in the future
 - (ageing) children of the oldest old will still be in employment and unable to care for their elderly parents

Population ageing is a major civilizational achievement we should be proud of.

The elderly are no longer a marginal group, their role in society is growing, also through informal activity.
