- ... serves as **joint strategic guideline** for the CE-countries/regions;
- ... will be **jointly developed with and for CE-countries/regions**;
- ... will cover a **wide range of policy interventions**;
- ... aims to establish **coordinated actions** at transnational, national, regional and local levels;
- ... will be developed by the Age Steering Group (ASG) with the help of **six senior experts of research and applied science**.

- ... will **link policies** horizontally;
- ... require **coordinated changes** at the transnational, national, regional and the local levels.

A set of up to 200 activities will be provided → regions shall choose the ones fitting to their settings and requirements.

Examples include **pilots**:

- _ promoting intergenerational staffing policy in SMEs, public authorities and service providers;
- _ new forms of work (short-time work, qualified part time work, etc.);
- _ regional training concepts/strategies.

Step 1 (December 2011 – March 2012): **joint vision for 2050** developed.

“In 2050 we want to live in a digital society in which human well-being has top priority and equality is a reality.”

Step 2 (March 2012 – May 2012): **current challenges, trends and scenarios for 2050** discussed.

WS1: 17 April 2012, Berlin, DE

Step 3 (May 2012 – December 2012): **content development process** to be implemented.

WS2: 13 June 2012, Linz, AT

WS3: 17 September 2012, Vienna, AT

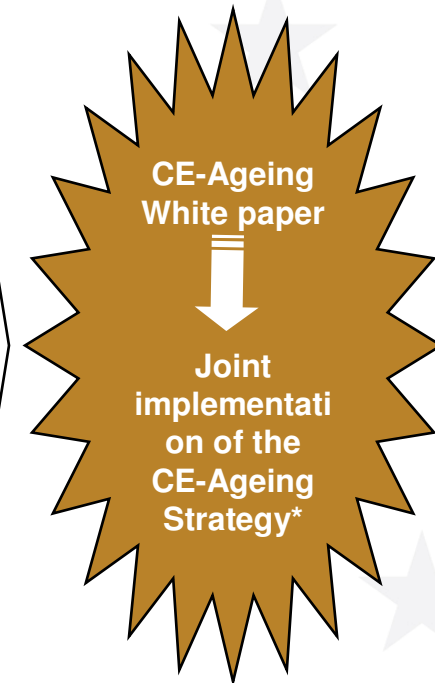
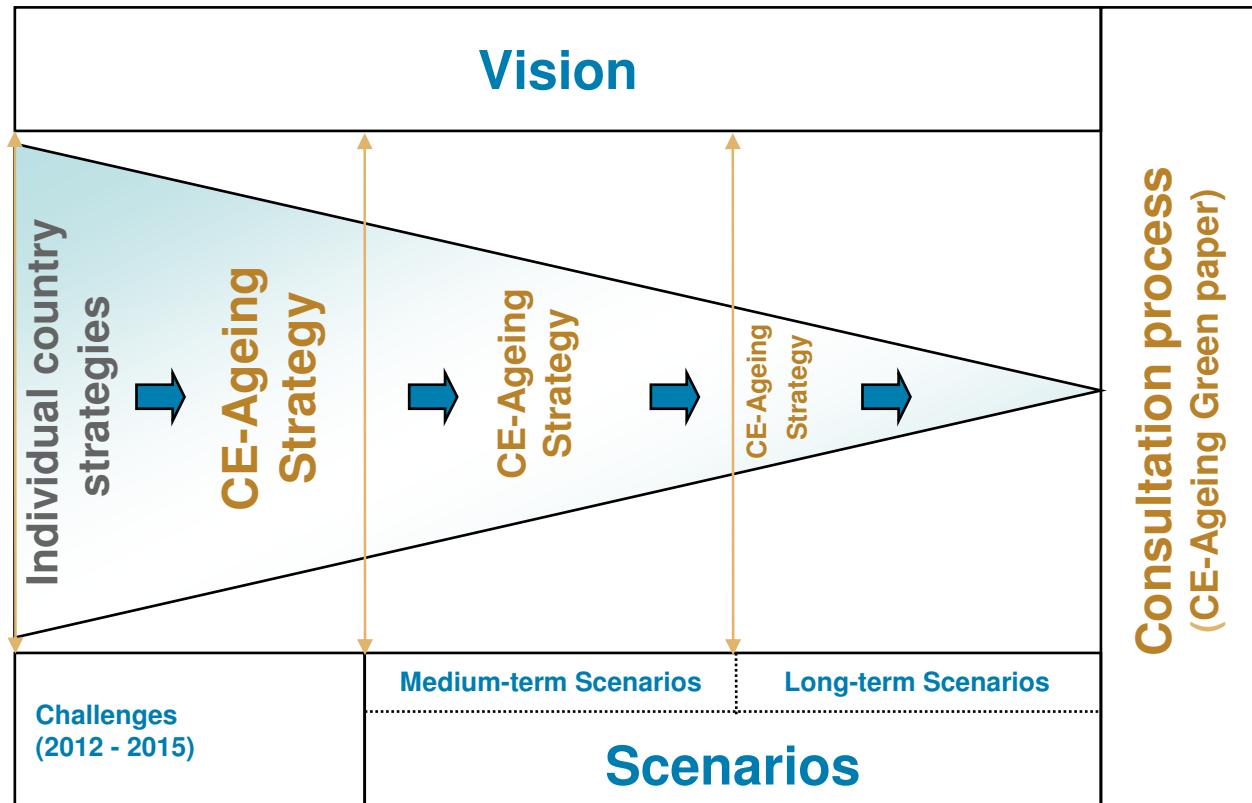


PHASE 3 :
